## Freeo, Arkansas

The old community of <u>Freeo</u> was located in northeast Ouachita County on the Camden-to-Princeton Road (Highway 9) about two miles south of the Dallas County line. A book of early post offices shows that there was a post office there from 1846 to 1877. The book gives the location as section 18 of Township 11 South, Range 15 West. <u>Freeo</u> appeared on an 1855 map of Ouachita County published by J. M. Colton & Company of New York. The name came from the Spanish word *frio*, meaning cold. The name <u>Freeo</u> is still used today as the name for a creek and a township in the county.
